Unfinished Business

Proposal To Replace Garfield School- Mayor Blackburn reported meeting with Jake Haak, Finance Supervisor with the Rogers Public Schools who reported the anticipated cost of \$400 per sq ft to construct ES17.

Mayor Blackburn will have 30 minutes airtime November 4, 2022, at 10:00AM on KURM Party Line, he invited representatives from Rogers Public Schools to attend

The final decision regarding the school will be made at the November school board meeting

Wilson Road & Ventris Loop – Mayor Blackburn advised that the project has been designed. He spoke with the engineers last week and should be receiving a \$15,000.00 bill for that portion which will be paid

form the \$68,000 grant received from Benton County. Jeremy Decker, owner of a local boring company has designed the cuts for Wilson and Ventris Roads.

Engineering Services Proposals

100,000-gallon standpipe –Scott Borman with BWRPWA advised to upsize water tank from 50,000 to 100,000 gallons. Mayor Blackburn advised the council that he reached out to Tank Connection who designed the 50,000-gallon tank to request the design of a 100,000-gallon tank. He received the design, and the cost will be an additional \$50,000.00 versus the 50,000-gallon tank.

Mayor Blackburn is scheduled to meet with Susan Hartman this Thursday to write a grant request to the State of Arkansas. If the grant is received the city would receive 50% funding.

Hydraulic Model of Water System (up-date 2003 version) – The city purchased a Dickson flow meter for \$1400.00. Water system distribution operator, Duncan, is placing it on hydrants and blow off valves on the system to record information about water flowing through the specific lines. The information is being provided to ESI who is continuing to work on the hydraulic analysis.

Fall Tree Giveaway - October 22, 2022- 9AM-12PM- 100 trees- 1 tree per family. Carroll Electric Arborist will be onsite to give planting and tree care information.

Proposed BWRPWA Rate increase & Local Increase- At the October board meeting of BWRPWA they will vote on a proposed 15 cent per thousand-gallon rate increase.

The water rate analysis conducted by Communities Unlimited in 2021 recommended a 2% rate increase in 2023. The analysis was done within the parameters that qualify for an ACT 605 water rate analysis. Mayor Blackburn is recommending a resolution in November or December to incorporate the 2% rate increase along with the proposed 15 cents per thousand increase in water rates.
